Holistic Skills Training

We educate to empower and therefore strive to develop the whole person (social, economic, emotional and spiritual). This is why all practical courses include the following life skills modules:

Level 1: **Personal Finance** introduces budgeting, saving and other smart tools.

Parenting Course addresses what it means to be a parent today.

Level 2: **Personal Development Course** equips the student with experiences of self and tools to express self. **Basic Business Skills Course** introduces the business idea, cycle, costing, pricing and asks: do you have what it takes to be an entrepreneur?

Level 3: **Way to Work Job Readiness Course** is designed to prepare the student with soft skills required to get a job, keep a job and move up in their career.

Level 4: **Business Skills Course** covers marketing and business plan development, finance and funding.

These life skills course may be attended separately from the practical skills courses.

The registration fee for all courses is R 100.

Practical Skills Courses

In each level students will make a 'pay it forward garment'.

Sewing School

Level 1

Duration: 3day/week for 6 weeks or Saturdays for 18 weeks

Modules covered: Control and threading of a domestic sewing machine. Developing a sample portfolio. Laying out and cutting fabric. Garments include: pillow case, apron, bag with applique, and panel skirt with pleats and a child's dress.

Total Course Cost: 160*

Level 2

Duration: 3day/week for 9 weeks or Saturdays for 24 weeks

Modules covered: Developing a skirt. Developing a ladies bodice basic block. Basic pattern making. Garments include: lady's dress with collar and darts, child's dress with smocking and a straight and panel skirt to fit.

Total course fee: 240*

Level 3

Duration: 5day/week for 9 weeks

Modules covered: This course will take students on a further journey into sewing. Students hone their sewing and professional skills by doing an internship in the clothing production environment.

Total course fee: 240*

Early Childhood Development

Level 1

Teacher Enrichment Course this course is designed to enrich both newcomers and experienced teachers who want to re-enliven their practice. The course covers early childhood development, how to support the emotional and physical changes in a child, health and nutrition, importance of play, movement and storytelling, artistic and craft activities.

Further levels are being developed. The enrichment course certificate serves as a recognition of prior learning when entering the NQF Level 4 Teacher Training at the Centre for Creative Education.
